Jack D. Scott 1930 - 2020 Jack D. Scott, 89, son of Harry and Gertrude Scott, was born August 19, 1930 in Atchison, Kan., and died on January 26, 2020 following a long battle with Parkinson's Disease. He graduated from Atchison High School in 1948 and attended Central Missouri State Teachers College for one year before entering the [United States Marine Corps](#) in 1950. He served in the Marines and saw duty in Korea. Following his discharge as a staff sergeant in 1953, he returned to college at Kansas State University, where he graduated in 1958 with a degree in mechanical engineering. He worked with the Gas Service Company, Kansas Power and Light, and Westar for 34-plus years. He was preceded in death by his parents and sister Virginia (Fred Dennis). He is survived by his loving wife of 53 years, Jane (Brice) Scott, sons Richard (Karen) Scott and Michael (Casie) Scott; his five grandsons Colin, Taylor, Connor, Ryan, and Logan; his sister's two children Scott (Terry) Dennis and Mary (Steve) Blackwell; and many nieces and nephews.
